

Campside Chef's Culinary Adventures Service Agreement

The following pertains only to the services rendered during the activity/service of the business "Campside Chef's Culinary Adventures".

Explanation of Activity/Service

Campside Chef's Culinary Adventures is a service provided for four to twelve clients for recreational & educational purposes. Among the services rendered are guidance in the activity of hiking, a tutorial on the history, flora and fauna of the mountain and the surrounding area, a tutorial in map & compass skills, and a freshly prepared lunch by the Campside Chef Ron Loeber at or near the summit of a pre-determined mountain.

Campside Chef Ron Loeber Responsibilities

Part I: The Campside Chef Ron Loeber & guide assistant shall conduct themselves in a professional and safe manner at all times during the activity/service.

Part II: The Campside Chef Ron Loeber & guide assistant will provide instruction about what the needs and expectations are before and during the hiking activity/service.

Part III: The Campside Chef Ron Loeber & guide assistant shall provide a fresh, safe and nutritious meal at a designated area that does not interfere with other hiker's enjoyment of the surroundings.

Client Responsibilities

Part I: All clients will act in a safe manner at all times during the activity/service.

Part II: All clients will act in a courteous and respectful manner towards the Campside Chef Ron Loeber, guide assistant and fellow clients/hikers at all times during the activity/service.

Part III: No client shall partake in any consumption of alcohol, illegal drugs, or smoking during the activity/service.

Part IV: All clients will be truthful and forthcoming in their assessment of their physical health and abilities including any prescription drugs

that might interfere or limit their ability to partake in the activity/service.

Part V: All clients will be courteous and respectful by limiting the use of their cell/smart phones during the activity/service.

Part VI: No client shall carry a weapon of his or her own during the activity/service. Only the small knife that comes with the backpacks that is provided by the Campside Chef Ron Loeber may be carried.

Part VII: It is the responsibility of the client to meet at the designated trailhead/parking area at the designated time or contact the Campside Chef Ron Loeber a minimum of one hour before the designated meeting time if running late. **If the client does not arrive at the pre-determined trailhead within one hour after the designated meeting time, the service is terminated and no refunds will be given.** The Campside Chef Ron Loeber does not provide transportation services.

Part VIII: It is the responsibility of the client to contact the Campside Chef a minimum of 48 hours before the start of the service/activity to be able to get a refund of non-deposit fees. Deposits are **non-refundable** but the rescheduling of the trip on another open date in the future is an option.

Pet Policy

Campside Chef's Culinary Adventures has a **no pet** policy simple due to variables out of my or the owners control which may include negative interactions with fellow hikers in the group, other hikers on the trail, and other animals on the trail both domestic and wild.

Client Gear/Supplies Recommended

Hiking Boots: Recommend a durable, comfortable, and broken-in pair of hiking boots for this activity/service. Breaking in your boots or sneakers on the trail is not an option.

Clothing: Please wear appropriate clothing for the hike and conditions, which may include rain gear and extra layers on cooler days. Clothing should be made of materials such as polypropylene, wicking, and nylon. Cotton is not a good choice since it absorbs sweat, does not insulate when wet, and takes a long time to dry.

Trekking Poles: The terrain can be steep and rocky at times and they will help keep a person stabilized on uneven terrain.

Gear/Supplies furnished by Campside Chef's Culinary Adventures

Cooking Gear & Supplies: The Campside Chef Ron Loeber & guide assistant will carry all of the food and cooking equipment.

Bear Spray: The Campside Chef Ron Loeber will carry bear spray for protection. Although an encounter with a black bear is highly unlikely, it will be ready just in case.

Backpacks: We provide up to twelve backpacks for our clients to use free of charge during the hike that are equipped with basic hiking essentials such as a fire starter kit, small pocket knife, bug spray, compass, first aid kit, emergency blanket, hand warmers, and headlamp. These may be purchased as is at the end of the hike for \$125 per pack.

Expectations

An important part of any service is to know the expectations of both the client and the person conducting the service. My expectations are to provide a safe as possible hike in an amazing natural environment with a great meal and tutorials on the history, flora, and fauna of the area we are hiking in along with other hiking skill activities.

We hope to exceed your expectations for this activity/service in every way. Your honesty in telling us your expectations ahead of time will limit the possibility of disappointment during the activity/service. We try to cater each trip to the expectations/needs of the client. There are limitations on what is possible but trying to minimalize them is the goal.
